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Hate Incidents and Hate Crimes

During the most recent reporting period there have been 271 hate incidents and crimes. This is a decrease of -25.1% compared to the previous period, and +11.1% increase compared to the same period last year.

The 134 hate incidents reported during this reporting period had 143 hate indicator markers against them as broken down in the Figure 3. This slight variation is because an incident can be marked with multiple indicator flags.

Figure 3 shows that during the current reporting period 51% of hate indicator markers related to *Race*, 22% *Homophobic*, 12% *Disabled*.

When reviewing at district level low volumes make it difficult to comment and small changes in volume can appear as large proportional changes.

A specific request has been made for the inclusion of a breakdown of hate incidents by ethnicity. This is included below and can be used to identify periods or districts experiencing an unexpected volume of hate incidents.

Hate Crimes

Current reporting shows that over the last two year period hate crime reporting has risen by approximately 29%. However, six months ago this same statistic was reported as a reduction of 6%; evidencing the extreme volatility which can occur when reviewing such small volumes.

Figure 11 shows the most used crime disposal to be charge, used in 68% of disposals. Second to this, restorative justice which is used in 14% of cases.

Satisfaction

In the year to date since April 2014 only 37 satisfaction surveys have been completed by persons of BME ethnicity. This equates to between one and eight satisfaction surveys being completed each month. With such a low sample volume is not possible to assess performance in this area.
